A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF WESTMINSTER, CALIFORNIA, ADOPTING A
LIST OF PROJECTS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2026-2027
FUNDED BY SENATE BILL (SB1): THE ROAD REPAIR AND
ACCOUNTABILITY ACT OF 2017

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 1 (SB1), the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017 (Chapter 5, Statutes of 2017) was passed by the Legislature and Signed into law by the Governor in April 2017 to address the significant multi-modal transportation funding shortfalls statewide; and

WHEREAS, SB1 includes accountability and transparency provisions that will ensure the residents of our City of Westminster are aware of the projects proposed for funding in our community and which projects have been completed each fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the City of Westminster must adopt by resolution a list of projects proposed to receive fiscal year funding from the Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account (RMRA), created by SB1, which must include a description and the location of each proposed project, a proposed schedule for the project's completion, and the estimated useful life of the improvement; and

WHEREAS, the City of Westminster, will receive an estimated \$2,551,474 in RMRA funding in Fiscal Year 2026-2027 from SB1; and

WHEREAS, this is the tenth year in which the City of Westminster is receiving SB1 funding and will enable the City of Westminster to continue essential road maintenance and rehabilitation projects, safety improvements, repairing and replacing aging bridges, and increasing access and mobility options for the traveling public that would not have otherwise been possible without SB1; and

WHEREAS, the City of Westminster has undergone a robust public process to ensure public input into our community's transportation priorities/the project list; and

WHEREAS, the City of Westminster used a Pavement Management System to develop the SB1 project list to ensure revenues are being used on the most high-priority and cost-effective projects that also meet the communities priorities for transportation investment; and

WHEREAS, the funding from SB1 will help the City of Westminster maintain and rehabilitate a main arterial throughout the City of Westminster this year and of similar projects into the future; and

WHEREAS, the 2023 California Statewide Local Streets and Roads Needs Assessment found that the City of Westminster's streets and roads are in an "good" condition and this revenue will help us increase the overall quality of our road system and over the next decade will bring our streets and roads into a "good" to "excellent" condition; and

WHEREAS, the SB1 project list and overall investment in our local streets and roads infrastructure with a focus on basic maintenance and safety, investing in complete streets infrastructure, and using cutting-edge technology, materials and practices, will have significant positive co-benefits statewide.

NOW, THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, ORDERED AND FOUND BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WESTMINSTER, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct.

SECTION 2. The following list of newly proposed projects will be funded in-part or solely with Fiscal Year 2026-2027 Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account revenues:

Bolsa Avenue Street Improvements from Brookhurst Street to Bushard Street. This project proposes to remove existing pavement and place new asphalt concrete overlay; remove and replace damaged curb, gutter, cross gutter, spandrel, sidewalk, driveway approach, and non-compliant ramps; install signing and striping. The estimated useful life for this project is between 15 to 20 years. Construction of this project is scheduled for July 2027.

Edinger Avenue Street Improvements from Bushard Street to Magnolia Avenue. This project proposes to remove existing pavement and place new asphalt concrete overlay; remove and replace damaged curb, gutter, cross gutter, spandrel, sidewalk, driveway approach, and non-compliant ramps; install signing and striping. The estimated useful life for this project is between 15 to 20 years. Construction of this project is scheduled for July 2027.

SECTION 3. The Mayor shall sign as to the passage, approval, and adoption of this Resolution.

SECTION 4. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this resolution and shall affix their signature and City Seal and that same shall be entered into the Book of Resolutions.
